

# How do I get a library card?



It's easier than ever! There are NO out of pocket expenses or visits to City Hall required when you sign up at the **Pinellas Park/Barbara S. Ponce Public Library**.

Located at **7770 52nd Street, Pinellas Park**

1. Bring your license/photo ID that lists your current\* home address.  
(\*or other proof of residence if you've recently moved - utility bill, rent receipt, etc.)
2. You'll be asked to fill out a library card application as well as a very brief reimbursement form. We will pay the library directly - no cost to you!
3. Your library card will be ready to use within minutes and is valid at any PPLC library, plus it includes access to ebooks & museum passes.
4. Your card is valid for 1 year. When it's time, you'll just repeat the process.

In-person verification at the library is required for anyone receiving a card.  
For any child younger than 16, the legal guardian must accompany the child to help with steps 1 & 2.
